This is a living document in that your valuable ideas / suggestions will be added to it.

Training / certification

The following training / certification is recommended for people wishing to visit detention centers.

Training and certification in "Child Safety Environments" and "Cross Cultural Competency" is available from ARA at no cost to ARA volunteers.
